Grown in the beautiful Majella Mountains, the grapes benefit from the cooling altitude in this otherwise warm and sunny region, retaining a good freshness. Some of the wine is matured for a short period in large old oak that provides a spicy complexity to the green fruit flavours and offers a generosity of mouthfeel. A perfect companion for fish and pasta dishes.

Made from the indigenous but often overlooked Nascetta varietal, which almost disappeared into extinction but was saved by a few brave winemakers including Elvio Cogno. With an initial production of just 800 bottles, this is now regarded as a benchmark for the style, with both exotic fruit and herbal flavours. This is richly textured to stand up to hearty white meat and powerful pasta dishes

2020 Vernaccia di San Gimignano

Arguably the best wine from the benchmark producer in this old fortress town of northern Tuscany, Montenedoli. Translated as 'the mountain of little bird nests', the grapes are surrounded by 200 hectares of woodlands, and they continue to farm sustainably. The wine spends a few months resting with yeast cells after fermentation, providing a rounded texture on the palate to stand up to a range of white meat and creamy pasta options.

Born from the careful selection of 12 different grape varieties, 6 native Tuscan grapes and 6 from France, all grown in the same vineyard, on a hill shadowed by Mount Amiata and not far from the sea. Its ages for two and a half years in oak barrels and refines for one year in bottles. The producer wanted to make a range of wines to have such individual personalities as to be right at the extreme of what was considered usual. For that reason, he decided to Play music to the vines to improve their growth. Thanks to the music and his passion for it, he discovered the benefit that the vineyard drew from it. The wine is very special and a lovely Earthy aromas and blackberries on the nose. The palate is full bodied, juicy and savoury with a long aftertaste.

This is an incredibly balanced and elegant Burgundy-style Nebbiolo from an estate owned by Paolo di Marchi of Isole e Olena fame. The Lessona soils create softer tannins than those of the Barolo & Barbaresco. The wine is matured for 32 months in old oak casks allowing for full development of perfumed red fruits, violets and an undertone of meaty and earthy flavours.

RED WINES FROM NORTHERN ITALY

A variety of styles ranging from the elegant yet structured Nebbioli in the north-west to rich and supple Amarones in the Veneto, whilst international varieties in the Friuli benefit from a freshness borne of the cooler climate. They all share a common juicy acidity that makes them perfect to accompany food.
